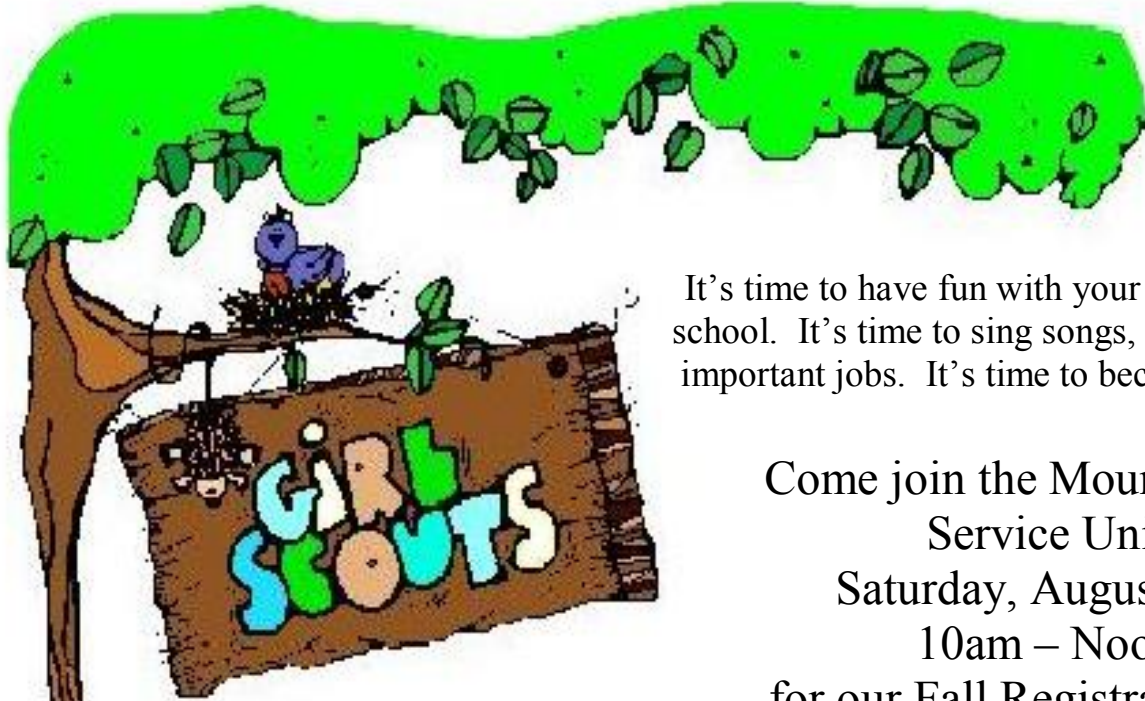


CALLING ALL GIRLS
